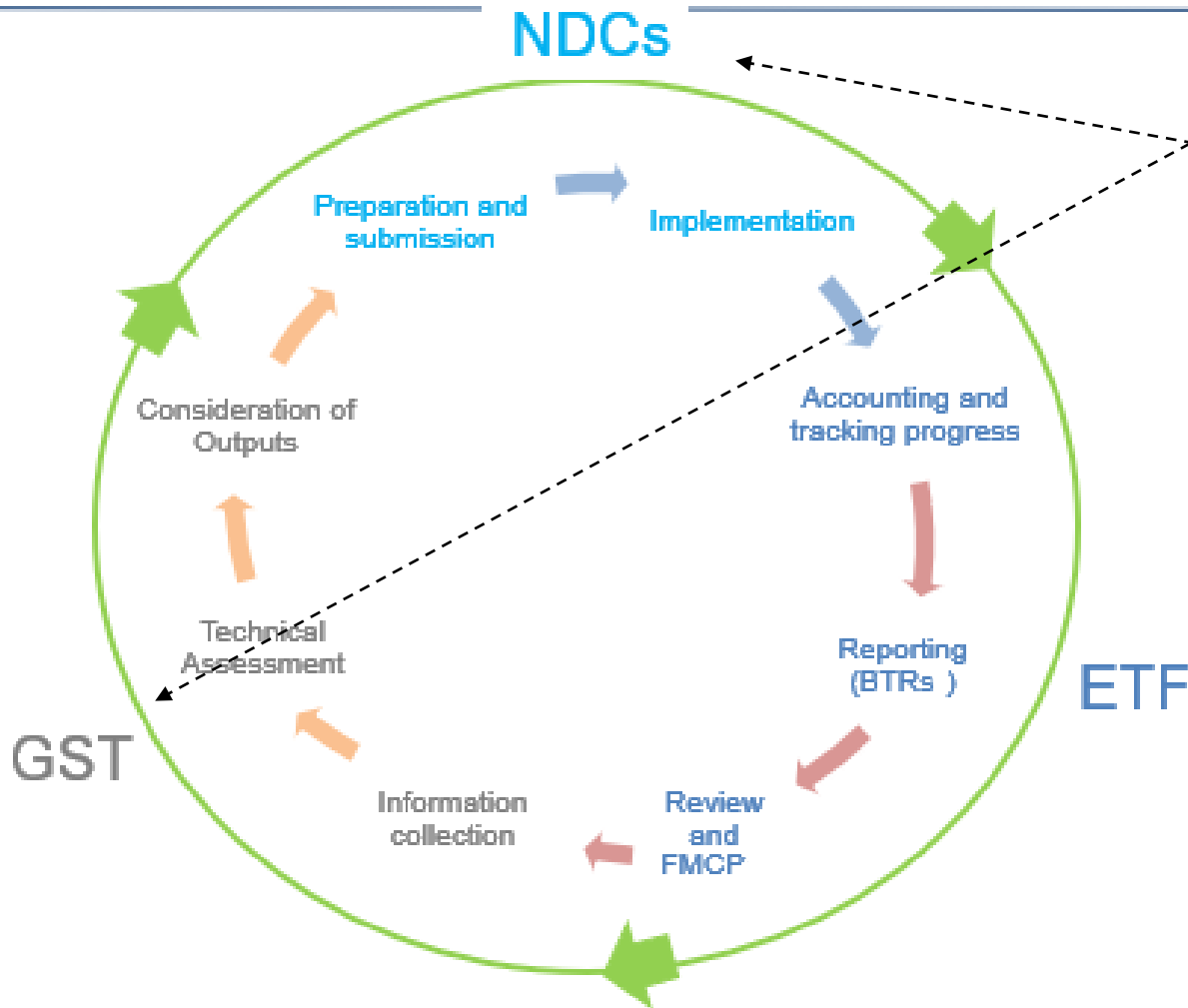

- Climate change impacts and adaptation [{Article 13.8}](#)



**Developed country Parties (shall) and other Parties that provided support (should)**

Financial, technology transfer and capacity-building support provided and mobilized to developing country Parties under Article 9, 10 and 11 [{Article 13.9}](#)

**Developing country Parties (should)**

Financial, technology transfer and capacity-building support needed and received under Articles 9, 10 and 11 [{Article 13.10}](#)

**All Parties (shall)**

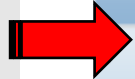
- Undergo technical expert review of information submitted under Articles 13.7 [{Article 13.11}](#)

- Undergo technical expert review of information submitted under Articles 13.9 [{Article 13.11}](#)

**All Parties (shall)**

Facilitative, multilateral consideration of progress with respect to efforts under Article 9, and its respective implementation and achievement of its NDC [{Article 13.11}](#)



# Technical Experts Needed



To support current and future MRV:

- Identify policy options/potential
- Tracking national action
- UNFCCC reporting
- UNFCCC review

## How to become a UNFCCC Reviewer?

**Step 1.** Register yourself on the Roster of Experts. This will alert your National Focal Point or the relevant intergovernmental organization to approve your self-nomination

**Step 2.** Complete relevant training programme, including passing the necessary exam(s)

**Step 3.** Participate on an expert team
