WHAT IS ARENA?

- Arena is a new Open Foris (OF) application that offers tools for storing, managing, and processing survey data.
- Arena works in a secure cloud server.
- Arena combines the main features of OF Collect and Calc.



WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES?

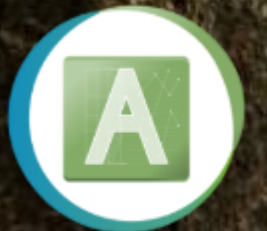
- It enables **collaboration** and **data sharing** in a working group.
- **Easy maintenance:** updates instantly available for all users.
- **No need for per-user installations.**



APPLICATION AREAS

Arena offers tools for

- collecting, hosting and archiving of
 - forest monitoring data, particularly collected in multicycle forest inventories,
 - botanical survey data,
 - socio-economic data, and
 - any other survey data.
- processing of survey data, integrated with R programming language.





CURRENT STATUS

- Arena 1.0 is a starting point for a new generation of online tools.
- Arena offers a technical platform which will be expanded.
- A technical training webinar will be provided in Sept '21
- FAO developers will add more features into Arena.
The following features are in the pipeline:
 - Templates for NFI data processing,
 - Inbuilt methods for data aggregation and reporting,
 - Data dashboard,
 - Functions for geo-spatial analysis.
